

# RESOLUTION 2018-09

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CULINARY WATER & SEWER RATES FOR ALL USERS SERVED BY WELLINGTON CITY.

**WHEREAS**, Wellington City contracts with Price River Water Improvement District for supply of culinary water and waste water treatment, and

**WHEREAS**, the Price River Water Improvement District has increased the rates it charges for culinary water and waste water treatment, and

**WHEREAS**, Wellington City needs to pass these increases on to the customers that are serviced by the Wellington Water and Sewer Utility, and

**WHEREAS**, the increases adopted by the Price River Water Improvement District are \$1.00 per month per connection for water service and \$1.00 per month per residential equivalent for sewer service, and

**WHEREAS**, the current rate structure is not sufficient to pay for inflation prior the past ten year period.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Wellington City Council of Wellington City that the rates for users of culinary water and sewer services supplied by the City, shall be increased effective January 01, 2019, as set forth in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and by this reference is made a part hereof.

**SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this resolution and the provisions adopted or incorporated by reference are severable.

**REPEALER.** The provisions of other resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

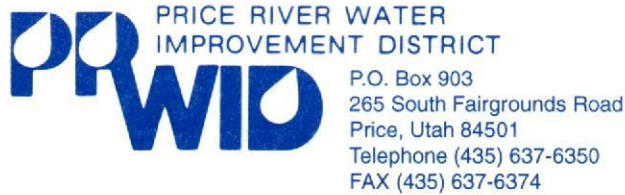

RE: Sewer and Water Rate Increase

Please accept this letter as official notice that the Board of Trustees of the Price River Water Improvement District approved a rate increase of \$1.00 per month per residential equivalent on June 5, 2018 for both the sewer and water rates. These rate increases were approved after advertisement of and convening a public hearing on that same date.

The sewer rate increase will become effective as of January 1, 2019. Our records indicate that this will bring the sewer rate paid by Wellington City to Price River Water Improvement District to \$21.83 per residential equivalent per month. The water rate increase will become effective as of January 1, 2020. Our records indicate that this will bring the base water rate paid by Wellington City to Price River Water Improvement District to \$24.25 per connection.
